Guidelines for oral presentation

- The total time allotted for each presentation is 8 minutes which includes 6 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for discussion
- Be considerate of other speakers and the audience by staying within your allotted time. Session moderators will hold you to the allotted time.
- Presentations should be in power point (MS PPT 2010-version) or PDF file, should be legible, most readable on a contrast background and bright lettering. Avoid using small fonts.
- Use the minimum number of words possible in titles, subtitles, and captions. Standard abbreviations are acceptable
- The sequence of the slides may be background/ purpose of the study, materials and methods, results, applications and scope for future research. It is preferable to restrict to a maximum of 10 slides
- Speak slowly and clearly using active words and short sentences.
